- c. Survival Characteristics: Describe the survival characteristics of your organism.
- d. <u>Discuss the reasons why your organism is endangered and what can be done to reverse</u> this process.
- 3. **Glossary:** Make your own glossary by <u>defining and alphabetizing</u> the following terms on the next page of the report. <u>Use all the terms in your report as you write.</u>
