Two types of observations:

- Qualitative-using your senses-i.e. colors or textures
- Quantitative-using measurements and numbers

Writing complete lab Conclusions:

- Always use RERUN
- This procedure will help you write great lab conclusions for all labs. You need to write a sentence or two about each of the letters!

Lab conclusions:

- RERUN
- R-restate the purpose and problem of the lab
- E-explain what was physically done in the lab
- R-results are to be stated and discussed
- U-uncertainties or errors need to be discussed and ways to improve upon the lab
- N-state two new ideas and concepts you learned while doing the lab. Also you must put this to use-state how you are going to use what you learned.
