Dear Parents and Biomedical Students:

Since 2010 as part of our school's PLTW Biomedical Sciences program we have implemented a student organization called HOSA (Health Occupations Students of America). HOSA is the place for students to expand upon the learning opportunities offered in the classroom. HOSA is not a club – it is an organization that promotes career opportunities in health care and supports young people who plan to pursue a health career.

In our HOSA Chapter, we stress leadership through the election of student officers. We encourage participation through social activities, leadership developments sessions, business meetings and friendly competition by means of skill and academic contests on the state and national level. Students are given multiple opportunities to engage in community service and learn from professionals in the health field. Over our short time we have seen much success in state competitions and have taken teams to nationals to compete in a wide variety of events.

We will be conducting short meetings every few weeks during before school on Fridays(calendar will be established soon) as well as co-curricular lessons between both HOSA and Biomedical classes. Outside of classroom time students can choose when their schedule will allow them to participate in community service, fundraising and competitions.

We try to keep the costs for affiliation at a minimum. Dues include: local chapter \$ 5.00, state dues \$10.00 and national dues \$10.00, for a total of \$25.00. Local dues are used to pay for postage, duplicating chapter materials, and for other HOSA needs. We will be planning fund raising activities to help offset the costs of attending conferences and competitive events.
