Application Criteria:

- **1.** Student must be a 27J School District graduating senior who has completed one full school year in the 27J District.
- **2.** Student must have a scholastic record of 2.5 cumulative GPA or better and provide a copy of his or her official high school transcript.
- **3.** Student must have been actively involved in the community and/or school activities. Submit a short resume to include any awards, community service, accomplishments, work (employment) history.
- **4.** Student must obtain and attach two (2) written references: one from a member of the high school staff and one from a community member who has direct knowledge of the applicant's community involvement. (No relatives.)
- **5.** The recipient must enroll in a university, college, community college or vocational school as a full time (12 or more credit hours) or part-time (6 credit hours) student. Award will be adjusted accordingly for part time enrollment.

Application Procedures:

- **1.** Submit your completed application with all required attachments to the 27J Education Foundation via email by **May 10, 2021**. Email: 27Jfoundation@sd27j.net
- 2. Successful applicants will be notified of his or her award at the Senior Breakfast or by mail.
- **3.** Payment of scholarships will be made directly to the Financial Aid office of the institution the student attends upon the 27J Education Foundation's receipt of proof of admission issued to the student. It is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure that 27J Education Foundation receives such proof. If proof is not received by 27J Education Foundation by the last day of September, the scholarship will be forfeited.
