We want to wish all of our families a safe and happy holiday season and remind you that there is no school for student's, Monday, Dec. 21st - Monday, Jan. 4th. All students will be Full Remote learning the week of Tuesday, January 5 - Friday, January 8, 2021. For students who

have previously selected the in person learning option, our plan is that Tuesday, January 12, 2021 will be the first day back for A Day students and Wednesday, January 13th will be the first day back for B Day students.

School will look the same with **SYNCHRONOUS (livetruction)** and **ASYNCHRONOUS (independent learning)** days of learning.

During synchronous learning (LIVE instruton) elective classes start at 8:00 am where they will begin their day. **ATTENDANCE** is still taken on synchronous days with phone calls going out if your child was marked absent in class. Attendance is required for all students. If your student will be absent please report their absence on the attendance line at 303-655-4056.

CHROMEBOOKS!

If your student is having technology issues please have them submit a ticket through their GRADE LEVEL google classroom. Once we are aware of the issue a VIKAN staff member will be in contact with your student regarding the next steps which may include you having to stop by VIKAN for troubleshooting or the exchange of your student's Chromebook.



Brighton School District 27j and Vikan Middle School must comply with the Colorado State Immunization Laws, which means that your student must be excluded from public school/child care until a completed updated immunization record is received. This also includes virtual students enrolled in 27J Schools. **The Exclusion date will be enforced starting on January 11th, 2020. To avoid an unnecessary exclusion from school, your student must be "In Process" with a confirmed appointment, have a copy of the updated immunization record, or have a signed and dated medical, personal, or religious exemption on file at school.** Personal and religious exemptions must be renewed every year.
