

RQMS PAC Meeting

November 8, 2018

Meeting called to order 6:06pm

Attendance: Mrs. Norris-Buck, Mrs. Brown, Carie, Kristin, Jessica, Derek

- Mrs. Norris-Buck gave an overview of procedures for identifying a school threat. The threats are processed and thoroughly investigated by top level administration and law enforcement.
- Students survey results are as follows:

565 students responded to the survey; 84%

The top 5 choices among all grades are for clubs are:

Art, Spanish, Lego, STEAM, and chess.

For the art club a parent volunteer has come forward as a sponsor and is currently working with the art teacher. All clubs are in need of a volunteer to establish the club.

Grade specific results:

- 8th Grade results:

26% of the students want be part of NJHS—Mrs. Brown is planning a mini induction ceremony for 1/2019 and possibly introducing a service project in the spring.

75% of the students are interested in a class trip to DC

- 7th Grade results:

20% of students want to be WEB leaders in 8th grade; students need to apply during 7th grade

26% of students are interested in joining NJHS

63% of the students are interested in a class trip to DC

- 6th Grade results:

25% interested in becoming WEB leaders

25% interested in joining NJHS

75% of the students are interested in Outdoor Ed.

57% of students are interested in a class trip to DC

A slide show of specific activities for the students is on file

- Spring sports available to 6th grade:

Wrestling, Track, Boys/Girls soccer.

- The RQMS Yearbook is in process, there is some discussion among school staff members on how to possibly make it an elective class or a club.
- Mrs. Brown asked for volunteers to label books given to her department. Some people volunteered at the meeting. If needed an email will be sent to the parents asking for more volunteers.
