## Prairie View High will gain more space



The process to design a new commons space area to be built at Prairie View High School continues this summer.

Humphries Poli Architects is designing the addition with the goals of enlarging the commons space and providing a more secure main entry at the school.

The new commons space would create a secure vestibule entry and a security office with visitor check-in. An office space for the school resource officer will also be added.

The space is also being designed to offer a place where students can gather inside. The new addition will also be used as a seating area during lunchtime.

A general contractor is being hired to be part of the planning process for the construction, which is scheduled to begin in spring 2020. The addition will be built and ready for students and staff to use by fall 2020.
