#### Graduation Requirements - Overview



#### Make a Plan, Find a Path

Graduation planning begins with the end in mind. Students should make a plan for post-graduation success and frequently update it.

Students must plan to complete the required coursework, electives, and college and career-ready demonstrations.



#### **Credit Completion**

A minimum of 46 semester credits are required for graduation.


## How do I know if I am on track to demonstrate with the SAT?


The PSAT 9 and PSAT 10 can help predict your SAT score.

- 2. On the left side, select "More"
- Select "<u>Assessments</u>" to see the earned score on the PSAT 9/PSAT 10


